

+3 DESTINATIONS, ONE PORT:

AN UNPRECEDENTED MILESTONE

In a single day, three cement loads simultaneously departed from our Argos Free Trade Zone terminal in Cartagena, Colombia, heading to different destinations in the Americas.



Argos Free Trade Zone, Cartagena, Colombia



- ▶ From platform 1, we loaded over 7,000 metric tons of bulk cement destined for the **Antilles**.
- ▶ From platform 1, we loaded over 3,000 metric tons of packaged cement destined for the **Caribbean islands**.
- ▶ From platform 2, we loaded over 21,000 metric tons of bulk cement destined for the **United States**.

A perfect synchrony!

Trading and Colombia Regional teams, and staff from the dock worked continuously toward a single purpose: **to take full advantage of Argos' logistics network to serve our customers in international markets.**



The numbers are **LITERALLY** heavy:

As of the close of July 2025, we reached a load volume of...

▶ **+570,000** metric tons of bulk cement on 44 ships.

This is the equivalent of lifting the Eiffel Tower approximately **70 times!**



▶ **+50,000** metric tons of packaged cement on 15 ships.

It represents the weight of **+350 blue whales**, the largest animal on the planet.



That's not all...

Every year, 3.5 million metric tons of product are shipped from Argos Free Trade Zone terminal, in Cartagena, Colombia.

From another perspective...

With this amount, every year we could build over **20 skyscrapers** the size of the Burj Khalifa, the tallest building in the world.
